This Month in AA History

Aug 3, 1954 – Brinkley S. gets sober at Towns Hospital after 50th detox. Aug 8, 1879 – Dr. Bob born in St. Johnsbury, VT. Aug 11, 1938 – Akron & NY members begin writing stories for Big Book. Aug 16, 1939 – Dr Bob and Sister Ignatia admit 1st alcoholic to St. Thomas Hospital, Akron, Ohio. Aug 19, 1941 – 1st AA Meeting in Colorado is held in Denver. Aug 25, 1943 – AA group donates Big Book to public library in Quincy, MA. *Other significant events in August for which we do not have a specific date: 1934: Rowland H and Cebra persuade court to parole Ebby T. to them. 1981: Sales of the Big Book passes 3 million.
