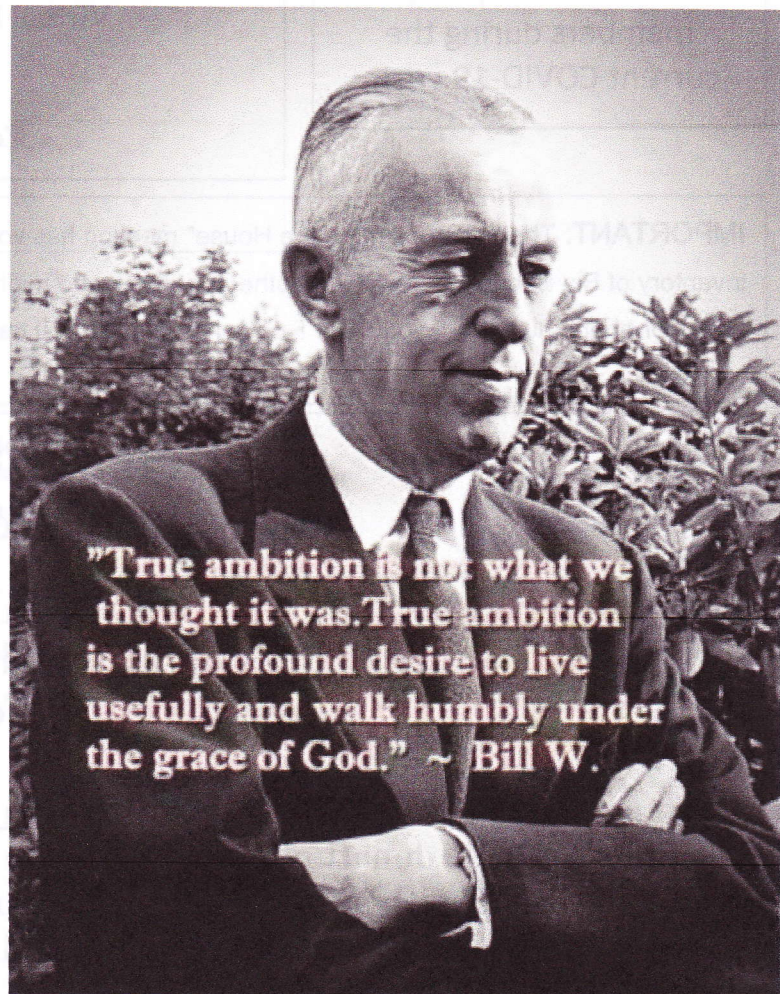


Welcome to the 2021 District 48 Newsletter!
